

The Audition Process - Musician

The audition process consists of four parts:

The Application

The application will ask about your personal background and musical experience and also a written testimony concerning your relationship with Jesus. Please fill out the application and return it to Pastor Chris as soon as possible. The audition process cannot proceed until the application is able to be reviewed by the worship staff.

The Musical Audition

Please prepare a musical piece to perform of your choice. You will also be asked to accompany another instrument or vocalist and play a piece of music given to you at the audition. Knowledge of reading sheet music is not mandatory if the instrumentalist possesses sufficient ear-training and/or theory and can read a basic chord chart. You will be evaluated based on the following: timing, execution, dynamics, confidence, accuracy, improvisation, blend (accompaniment), tone, pitch (where applicable).

The Personal Interview

You will be asked to meet with one of the Worship Team leaders for a personal interview. This will help us to get to know you better and to help direct you to the area of ministry that allows the best expression of your gift.

The Invitation

Following your interview, you will be either invited to become a member of the worship team and asked to make a one-year commitment, or you will be advised to try again after a six-month period. Any issues with your audition will be addressed personally. The final decision to accept the invitation will be yours.

The Audition Process - Vocalist

The audition process consists of four parts:

The Application

The Application will consist of personal information and music experience and also a written testimony concerning your relationship with Jesus. Please fill out the application and return it to Pastor Chris or the Front Office Receptionist as soon as possible. The auditioning process cannot proceed until the application is able to be reviewed by the Worship Staff.

The Musical Audition

You will be asked to demonstrate your ability by singing a familiar chorus used in our church services with keyboard or guitar accompaniment. If you are able to hear different vocal parts, please be prepared to demonstrate that ability. If you do not have a song prepared, you will be asked to sing Amazing Grace.

The Personal Interview
